

CV for Donal C. Tunnell

Don Tunnell has a career in the music and video business of over 35 years. He began as a musician playing bass guitar in a rock band opening shows for bands like Moby Grape, The Yardbirds, Blue Cheer, and Country Joe & The Fish. In 1972 he entered the music booking agency business in the Seattle and Los Angeles offices for General Entertainment Corporation. They were one of the top five (5) agencies in the USA at the time. He settled in Los Angeles in 1979 and began personal management of artists such as Perfect Tommy, USK, Spencer Davis, Mark Spiro, and Skip Martin (lead vocalist for The Dazz Band & Kool & The Gang). Don also produced a live stage revue show with a 37-member cast at Commerce Casino in Los Angeles.

In 1994 he moved to Las Vegas and took a position as Vice President of Sho Pro Inc. a Dallas, TX based entertainment company. He was head of Artist Management and Video Production and managed the Las Vegas office. Tunnell's Producer and Director credits include (2) two long-form live concert video projects featuring Jimmy Page and Robert Plant. Other productions feature Bill Wyman, Ted Nugent, The Rolling Stones, Candlebox, Metallica, Chisato (Japan's Rolling Stones), and others were produced.

Don married Suzette Albers in Los Angeles in 2003 and moved from Los Angeles to Boise, Idaho in October 2004. He is operates his Personal Management and Artist Development company, Tunnell International from Boise. He also operates his Video Production company, TEV Media1 from Boise.

Don attended Lewis Clark State University and The University of Idaho where he majored in Radio TV Communications, and minored in Political Science. He graduated from Columbia School of Broadcasting in San Francisco, and The American Writers and Artists Institute in Deerfield Beach, Florida.
